**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

TERI SAS will also provide certification to the students of Kalindi College for the work undertaken by them in the project.

Following shall be the activities carried out by the two institutions:

**A. Kalindi College :**

- To isolate the microbes from the three types of soil samples
  - Reclaimed and un restored land
  - Reclaimed sites with afforestation and
  - Overburdens
- To identify and characterise the bacteria isolated from the aforementioned types of soil
- To create a database and assess the changing diversity if any correlated with changing soil profile

**B. TERI SAS :**

- To do a spore count of arbuscular mycorrhizal fungi (AMF) from the soil of the site.
- To apply the enumerated AMF to the reclaimed site.
- To assess effect of AMF on the inoculated plants.

In addition to the aforementioned activities, both the institutions will work towards the pursuit of higher education through faculty and students participation in scientific research.

This MOU shall be valid until March 31<sup>st</sup> 2018 and will be extended with mutual consent of both the institutions.

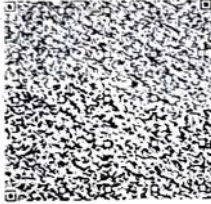




