



By all accounts, a partition of Bennett, Coleman and Company Limited appears imminent. Samir and Vineet Jain, who co-own and built the conglomerate, are set to part ways. Amongst the group's various entities, Samir is expected to take the Times of India, while Vineet will retain control of Times Now. This split marks a significant juncture in the media landscape—and a departure from the era when the conglomerate set industry standards. BCCL has been instrumental in shaping the current media landscape, but its business interests often came at the cost of journalistic depth. The group is no longer unrivalled in terms of both revenue and readership. Eleven years after this magazine last profiled the Jains, BCCL is no more the leading media conglomerate it once was. The businesses are strained, rumors of tensions between the brothers abound and the group is on the brink of division.







EDITORIAL

Global economy has been into state of constant and complex flux over the last decade or so. Amidst such changing scenario India has made the most of it. 'Brand India' has been looming large all over the globe by the year 2023. The year commenced with bagging of two Oscars, followed by sending an indigenous rocket to moon and Solar Mission Aditya has been put into orbit to travel nearly 15 lakhs kilometers to approach Sun and explore the star. India also hosted a successful G-20 Summit and effectively showcased its 'soft power' assets to the world. India's presidency of G-20 must be counted as one of the most successful one with the onset of "Delhi Declaration' that speaks volume about its diplomatic knack and resources.

It has attained the 'fifth largest economy' status being among the fastest growing economies in the world behind only US, China, Japan and Germany. International Monetary Fund calculations reveal that India will move into the fourth place in 2025 and into the third place in 2027. According to IMF it is scheduled to be USD 5.4 trillion-economy by 2027. According to World Bank data in terms of Purchasing Power Parity India is the fourth largest economy within the G-20 grouping. Even in 2022-23 the Indian economy grew at 7.2 %.

Its global influence and outreach has increased in a meaningful way. 
