

Rasaynika 2024, an annual intercollegiate festival, was held on February 28, 2024, by Rasaion, the chemical society of Kalindi College. Science for a sustainable future was the festival's theme. 


CHEMBOLA:




Detailed Report:

On May 3, 2024, Rasaion, the chemical society of Kalindi College, held its closing ceremony for the 2023–2024 session in TRI-5. The event began with a welcome from the vice president, Annu Yadav, and Tanushree, a first-year student of the chemical society. The dignitaries lit the lamp and Annu Yadav gave the guest speaker, Dr. RK Kotnala, a plant plot, while our staff advisor, Dr. Yogesh Kumar Sharma, presented the convenor with a plant pot as a token of respect.

LECTURE BY THE GUEST SPREAKER:

First, a talk on his study topic was given by guest speaker Dr. R.K. Kotnala. An Indian scientist, Dr. R K Kotnala is internationally recognised for his outstanding contributions to the fields of net carbon zero, hydroelectric cells, water splitting by non-photocatalytic processes, nanomaterials, multiferroics,



spintronics, magnetics, and biomedical devices metrology. Together with Dr. Jyoti Shah, Dr. Kotnala has made a significant contribution to the groundbreaking development of a clean and green energy technology called the hydroelectric cell through his unwavering commitment and hard work. An extraordinary, amazing, and miraculous innovation in the field of green energy, the hydropower cell is the key to reaching net carbon zero. Dr. Kotnala is renowned in the scientific community for his exceptional work in the fields of environmental sciences, solar cells, multiferroics, spintronics, clean energy, and values of scientific ethics. He has authored numerous books and chapters in addition to giving innumerable scholarly presentations in a variety of fields. Additionally, he is educating young people about science by giving a lot of invited presentations and making YouTube movies about basic scientific ideas.



As a token of appreciation, Dr. Renu Bala, the convenor of the chemistry department, and Dr. Aparajita Gaur gave him a gift and a memento. His inspiring speech inspired all the young minds to pursue the career path he suggested.
