



Description - Tech to toe the ultimate tech quiz and visualization competition where various tech based questions will be asked.

Eligibility - Only students of Universities and Colleges of Delhi NCR can participate with valid IDs.

All you need to know:

- **1.** Students from any college in India are welcome to participate.
- 2. Individual participant only.
- 3. This event will be conducted in two rounds.

Prelims (Round 1): Participants will be provided with different tech related and aptitude-based questions in this round.

Level 1 (L1):

Focus: Basic technical knowledge, fundamental computing concepts, and general awareness of emerging technologies. Consist 30 MCQ question for 30 mins per question 1 min.

Level 2 (L2): Final Round

Focus: Advanced technical knowledge and analytical thinking. Coding questions in which you have to build logic and write. Consist 5 questions for 25 minutes each question 5 mins.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Eligibility: All students of Universities and Colleges of Delhi
 NCR can participate with valid ID Cards
- Match Setup: Players will be grouped into rooms with a maximum of 32 players per room. Multiple rounds will be held based on participation.
- **Game Mode:** Matches will be played in Solo TPP mode to evaluate individual performance.
- Time Limit: Each match will run for a maximum of 10 minutes. After the time ends, the game will be forcefully concluded.
- Winning Criteria: The player with the highest number of kills at the end of 10 minutes will qualify for the next round.
- Progression Format: Winners from each room will be regrouped for the next round. The same format will continue until the final winner emerges.
- **Devices**: All participants must bring their own devices such as a mobile phone, tablet, or laptop to play. No devices will be provided by the organizers.
- Fair Play: Any use of hacks, emulators, triggers, or unfair means will result in instant disqualification. The decision of the organizing team will be final and binding.
- **Reporting Time:** Participants must report 15 minutes prior to their match. Latecomers may not be allowed to participate.



Rules & Regulations

1. Eligibility:

- Open to all undergraduate students of all universities and colleges in Delhi NCR (individuals or teams of up to 3–5 members).
- Each team can submit only one idea.

2. Registration:

- All teams must register by the given deadline.
- Team names and idea titles must be unique and appropriate.

3. Idea Submission:

- Submit a brief executive summary (1-page) covering:
 - Problem statement
 - Proposed solution
 - Target market
 - Revenue model (if applicable)
 - Unique selling point (USP)
- Optional: Pitch deck (max 5-7 slides) or short video (2-3 mins).

4. Round Structure:

- Round 1: Screening / Idea Submission
- Judges shortlist teams based on originality, feasibility, and clarity.
- Round 2: Elevator Pitch (Semi-finals)
- 2–3 minute verbal pitch without slides, followed by 2 mins of Q&A.
- Focus on clarity, confidence, and viability of the idea.
- Round 3: Final Pitch (Grand Finale)
- 5 minutes detailed pitch presentation (PPT allowed), followed by 2 mins Q&A.
- Must cover business model, market research, competition, and finances (if applicable).

5. Rules During the Event:

- No offensive or plagiarized content.
- Time limits will be strictly enforced.
- Only team members can present; no external assistance.
- Judges' decision will be final and binding.
